## REQUEST TO WITHDRAW

I, DEEPIKA (student's name and surname), the undersigned, enrolment no. T1016750 (enrolment no.), hereby request to **withdraw** from the first- /  second- / third-cycle (mark accordingly) professional / academic / integrated master's / master's / doctoral (mark accordingly) study programme in TOURISM DESTINATIONS AND EXPERIENCES (name of the study programme) of the FACULTY OF TOURISM (name of the faculty) of the University of Maribor.

I, the undersigned, hereby declare that I am withdrawing from the above-mentioned study programme of my own free will and that I am informed upon withdrawal that my student status and related rights and benefits arising from the Higher Education Act (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, No. 32/12 - official consolidated text with amendments up to 102/23, hereinafter referred to as "ZViS") and the Statute of the University of Maribor (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, No. 100/2023 – UPB 14) will cease on the day of withdrawal.

I am withdrawing from the above-mentioned study programme (mark accordingly):

I, the undersigned, hereby declare that I am aware that if a student withdraws from a study programme because they want to enrol in a new study programme before the end of the academic year, they retain student status in accordance with ZViS until the end of the academic year (i.e. until 30 September). I also declare that I have been informed that the student status is retained on the condition that the student withdraws from the existing study programme and enrolls in a new study programme during the application and enrolment deadlines, as the student's intention to transfer can only be considered upon submission of their application for enrolment, whereby the intention is considered realized only upon enrolment in a new study programme after the selection process has been completed. I declare that I understand that this consequently means that if the student withdraws from a study programme outside of the application and enrolment deadlines specified in the call for enrolment, the withdrawal cannot be attributed to the desire to exercise the right to change the study programme or study option, and as a result, the student status ceases on the day of withdrawal.
