* **Key to Cambridge Technical and BTEC Grades:** D*=Distinction*, D=Distinction, M=Merit, P=Pass, N=Near Pass. Where a Double award is studied, two grades will be shown.

Where a student has not passed a mock exam we will be following this up with students and confirming next steps on an individual basis.

UCAS grades are based on the assessments that students have done in Year 12; in particular the Year 12 summer mock exams. UCAS grades must be data driven – we must have some evidence that a student could achieve these grades. UCAS grades cannot be inflated just because a student wants to apply to a particular course or a particular university.

The **Most Likely Grade** (MLG) is the grade based on all the evidence available at this point in time that a student is most likely to achieve at the end of Year 13.

The **Ready to Learn Score** is measured on a scale of 4-1 and is not an assessment of academic ability. The criteria can be found below. For RtL scores of 3 or below, you will see a target either related to learning in the classroom or learning beyond the classroom.

Ready to Learn (RtL) in the Sixth Form

A Sixth Form student will:

- Demonstrate an independent approach to learning
- Regularly work above and beyond expectations
- Respond to challenge with resilience and actively seek feedback on how to improve the quality of their work
- Be fully engaged and actively participate in lessons
- Be organised, meet deadlines and manage their time effectively

RtL 2 = Sometimes

RtL 1 = Hardly Ever
