The comprehensive program laid a strong foundation in computing and engineering theories and practical applications. Courses such as Data Structures and Algorithms, Data Mining and Warehousing, and Artificial Intelligence provided me with in-depth insights into the field. One of my main projects, an Apparel Store application, helped me understand backend processes in web development. This project was awarded the best project and secured my first job as a Database Administrator at Gemstones.

While working there for more than two years, I gained extensive knowledge in backend management, which motivated me to pursue an internship in Full Stack Development (MERN stack) for six months. This experience led to my second job as a Software Associate at Bharat Softwares, where I applied my skills in a practical environment. After working in the software industry, I developed a keen interest in understanding the software development lifecycle, which led me to pursue further studies in Germany. Germany tops my list due to its reputation for excellence in technical education and research, as well as its emphasis on experiential learning.

This approach leads to faster time-to-market, improved product quality, and enhanced customer satisfaction through frequent releases and iterative improvements.

Additionally, FH Schmalkalden's strong international orientation, exchange programs, and partnerships with universities worldwide will provide me with valuable global exposure. As a public university in Germany, it also offers affordable tuition fees, making quality higher education accessible.
