

Note:

1. The University has been established by an Act of the Legislature of the State of Haryana (Act XVII of 1995) notified on October 20, 1995. In terms of Haryana Vidhan Sabha Secretariat Notification No.8-HLA of 2006/36 dated the 23rd March 2006, of Haryana Govt. Gazette (Extra) the name of Guru Jambheshwar University has been changed as Guru Jambheshwar University of Science & Technology.
2. In case of any discrepancy, this Result-Cum-Detailed marks Card should be returned to this office, within a month from the date of its dispatch. After the expiry of one month, a fee of **Rs.200/-** shall be charged.
3. As a consequence of revision of result, old DMC shall be replaced by a fresh one.
4. A Fresh Detailed Marks Card is issued in lieu of Old Detailed Marks Card having SI. No. _____ received back and cancelled due to revision of result/ correction in particulars etc.
5. First duplicate DMC is issued with a fee of Rs.500/- on the request of the candidate without affidavit. However he/she will submit self declaration about the loss of original DMC. The second duplicate DMC is issued with a fee of Rs.1000/- along with an affidavit issued by First Class Magistrate.
6. Any candidate may apply for re-evaluation of answer-book (s) in theory papers only on the prescribed form in an examination taken by him/her within 15 days of the date of uploading/dispatch of detailed marks card, enclosing Original Detailed Marks Card Certificate and fee as prescribed for re-evaluation.
7. The Controller of Examination, in exceptional cases, may permit, with a late fee of Rs.1000/- in case of a candidate who submits the re-evaluation form after stipulated period but not later than 30 days of the uploading/ dispatch of DMC.
8. No answer-book will be re-evaluated on any round whatsoever if re-evaluation form is received after 30 days of the uploading/dispatch of DMC.
9. Re-evaluation shall not be permitted in case of papers which have already been evaluated by two examiners (External & Internal). Dissertation, Project Report, Practical Examination, Sessionals, Internal Assessment, Assignments, Viva-Voce etc.
10. Grading of performances

Letter grades and grade points allocations :

Based on the performances, each student shall be awarded a final letter grade at the end of the semester for each course.

| Percentage of Marks Obtained | Letter Grade | Grade Point | Performance |

| 90.00-100 | O | 10 | Outstanding |
| 80.00-89.99 | A | 9 | Excellent |

| Less than 50 | F | 0 | Fail |
| Absent | AB | 0 | Fail |

A learner who remains absent for any end semester examination shall be assigned a letter grade of AB and a corresponding grade point of zero. He/She should reappear for the said evaluation examination in due course.

Note: The class shall be awarded on the basis of CGPA as follows:

- First Class with Distinction = CGPA of 7.50 and above
- First Class = CGPA of 6.00 to 7.49
- Second Class = CGPA of 5.00 to 5.99

11. Calculation SGPA and CGPA are as under:-

$$SGPA = \frac{C_1G_1 + C_2G_2 + C_3G_3 + C_4G_4 + C_5G_5 + \dots}{C_1 + C_2 + C_3 + C_4 + C_5 + \dots}$$

$$CGPA = \frac{C_1S_1 + C_2S_2 + C_3S_3 + C_4S_4 + C_5S_5 + C_6S_6 + C_7S_7 + \dots}{C_1 + C_2 + C_3 + C_4 + C_5 + C_6 + C_7 + \dots}$$

Where C_1, C_2, C_3, \dots is the total number of credits for semester I, II, III, and S_1, S_2, S_3, \dots is the SGPA of semester I, II, III,

The overall percentage of marks obtained will be determined by multiplying the SGPA or CGPA, as the case may be, by 10.
