1. Eligibility for Pass

A student shall be declared to have passed in semester if he/she secures

- i) a minimum of 40% of marks as semester aggregate; and
- ii) a minimum of 40% marks in the end semester examination in each paper (theory/practical); and
- iii) an aggregate of 40% in each paper including internal assessment.

2. A student shall be declared to have failed in a semester if he/she secures less than 40% of marks in semester aggregate. He/she would be required to reappear in such papers where he/she has secured less than 40% marks including internal assessment.
