CGPA CONVERSION CERTIFICATE

I The Formula for percentage calculations:

$$\frac{\text{Marks Awarded for the core subject}}{\text{Total Marks}} \times 100$$

II The Formula for calculating : $CGPA = \frac{\sum [GP \times Credits]}{\sum [Credits]}$

GP - Grade Point

CGPA - Cumulative Grade Point Average

a. CGPA is calculated based on Credit and Grade Point secured by the student for each course.

b. Grade Point is based on the percentage of marks for each course, with a maximum value of $GP = 4 / 10$.

There is no direct relation between CGPA and percentage of marks scored by the student, as CGPA is calculated based on the Grade Point and Credits for all courses including the add-on courses, whereas percentage is calculated based on the marks scored in the core courses.

The Ranking system in the University is based on CGPA and not on percentage of marks.
