



## NOTE

### I. Awarding of Grades

- a) Regular/Private candidate is declared as having passed the Intermediate Examination if he/she gets a minimum of 30% marks in each paper and 35% in aggregate in one attempt and appropriate Grade is awarded basing on the following norms:

Sl.No.	Grade	Range of marks percentage
1	A	Greater than or equal to 75%
2	B	Greater than or equal to 60% and less than 75%
3	C	Greater than or equal to 50% and less than 60%
4	D	Greater than or equal to 35% and less than 50%

- b) Minimum pass marks for individual papers of first year and second year under compartmental appearance for Private candidate is 35% and the candidate is awarded **Compartmentally** pass without any Grade.
- II Blind, Deaf, Deaf & Dumb candidates are declared as passed 1<sup>st</sup> / 2<sup>nd</sup> year, if a candidate gets a minimum of 25% marks in each paper. The Grade is awarded basing on the marks secured in the papers appeared for.
- III The Deaf, Deaf & Dumb, Dyslexia & Mentally handicapped candidates are exempted from passing in one language either under part I or part II. The Grade is awarded basing on the marks secured in the papers appeared for.

Note: 'E' - INDICATES EXEMPTION from passing in one language either under Part I or Part II in case of Deaf, Deaf & Dumb, Dyslexia & Mentally handicapped candidates.

- IV **Environmental Education** is a compulsory qualifying subject from the Academic year 2006 - 07 and **Environmental Education and Ethics & Human Values** are compulsory qualifying subjects from the Academic year 2014-15 in 1<sup>st</sup> year. Marks secured in these subjects are not taken into account for awarding grade. Hence, marks secured are not shown against these subjects.

- a) Maximum marks for Theory & Project work are 60 & 40 respectively.
- b) A candidate should secure minimum 35% of marks in Theory & Project work put together. In case, the candidate appears for Theory & Project work separately, he/she should secure 35% marks separately in Theory & Project work.
- c) Blind candidates are exempted from passing in Environmental Education Examination only.
- d) The benefit of reduction of pass marks from 35% to 25% to Deaf, Deaf & Dumb candidates is also applicable for Environmental Education Examination.
