Please note that the scheduled date for your appointment is fixed and cannot be changed.

During your appointment, please ensure the submission of two sets of documents, comprising both originals and photocopies. Ensure that these documents are dated within the last 180 days and organized as follows:

- long-term visa/long-term residence permit application form
 - copy of the passport
 - acceptance letter in Czech language
 - proof of accommodation in Czech language
 - stamped and signed bank statement, accompanied by a copy of the international debit card bearing your name, issued by the same bank
 - police clearance certificate accompanied by a certified translation into Czech language conducted by one of the official translators approved by the Ministry of Justice of the Czech Republic
- upon request you are further obliged to submit police clearance certificate from the states in which, in the last 3 years, you have resided for a period longer than 6 months in its summary

Important notice:

For Indian nationals: The police clearance certificate must be issued by Regional Passport Office and apostilled prior to submission. Please ensure that the document undergoes the apostille process before presenting it along with your visa application.

For nationals of Sri Lanka, Maldives, and Bhutan: The police clearance certificate must be legalized at the Consular Department of the respective Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA) in your country. Prioritize this step to facilitate a smooth application process.
