DESCRIPTION OF THE EVALUATION PROCESS

Grade and Grade Point

The Evaluation of each Course comprises of Internal and External Components in the ratio 1:4 for all Courses. Grades and Grade Points are given on a 10-point Scale based on the percentage of total marks (ISA + ESA) as given in Table I.
